This information will be reviewed only by the Seacoast United Maine North Financial Aid Committee and the Club Registrar. Applications must be received by December 1, 2017.

### **Types of Financial Aid:**

- 1. Individualized Payment Plans:** This IS NOT A SCHOLARSHIP and does not reduce the total tuition due to the Club by the family. Instead, it allows the family to pay fees on a schedule that fits the family's need. This plan is different from the default payment schedule that is listed in the, 2017/18 Program Overview. - 2. Scholarships:** May range anywhere from 10% -100% the cost of tuition, excluding the cost of uniform kits. All families receiving Scholarships MUST PARTICIPATE in the club fundraising programs as part of their acceptance (see commitment statement).

All families receiving Financial Aid are expected to volunteer 10 hours per season to help SUSC provide the best soccer program in New England. These hours may include field maintenance, fundraising, or any other roles deemed appropriate by the Club.
